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Preoperative Mortality Predictor (PMP) Score

Predicts risk of perioperative mortality in general surgery patients.

When to Use	Pearls/Pitfalls	Why Use
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- Uses easily obtainable information preoperatively.
- Derived to aid in preoperative counseling and discussions of informed consent.
